**% = National Percentile:** Reflects the percentage of our students who performed at or above the fiftieth percentile in the nation (85% = 85% of our students scored at or above the fiftieth percentile in the nation).

**GE = Grade Equivalent:** Indicates the grade level, including the month into the year that the student tested at (8.7 GE = eighth grade, seventh month). An 8<sup>th</sup> grader should be performing at an 8.7 GE level. If they are performing at a 12.2 GE level, this means that the average student shows the achievement level of a 12<sup>th</sup> grader taking the 8<sup>th</sup> grade SAT test.

**PHS GE =** Post High School grade equivalent

### **Three types of tests measure three different aspects of student learning:**

**Achievement Tests:** Measures "How much does a student know?" Measures what they can do or what they know. (i.e. Stanford Achievement Test, ACT college test). First through eighth grades participate in the Stanford Achievement Test each year.

**Mastery Tests:** Measures whether a student meets a specific standard based on specific information required for mastery. (i.e. driver's license test, HSPE, WASL).

**Ability Test:** Measures a student's potential for learning. (Scholastic Aptitude Test, Otis Lenin Ability Test). NCA first, third, fifth and seventh grades are testing in the OLSAT test each year.

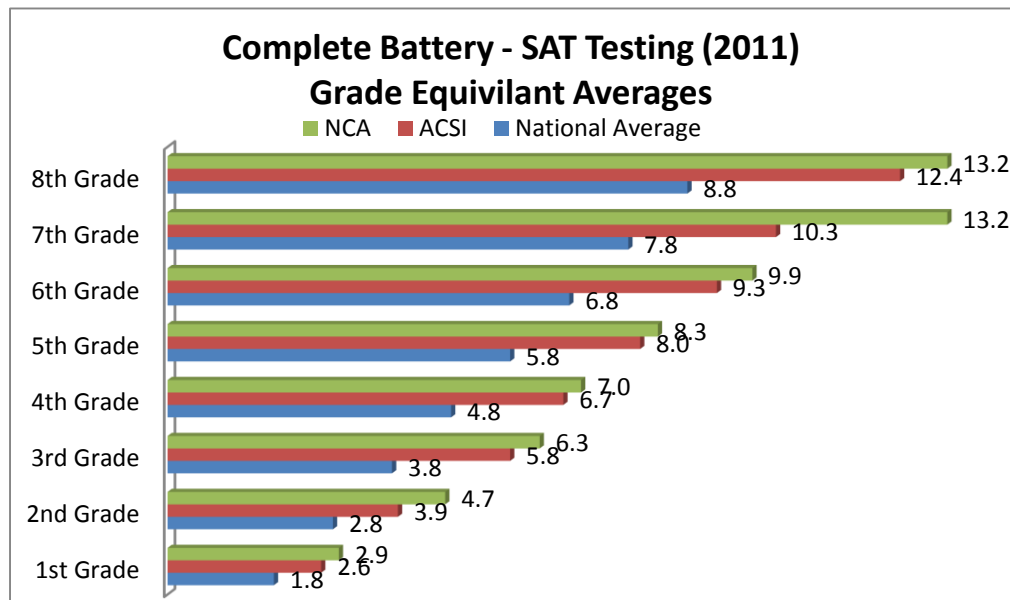
