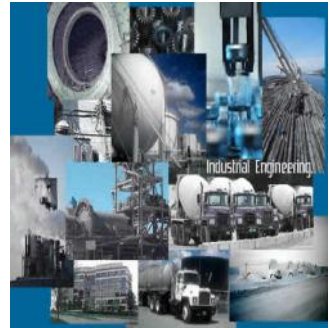

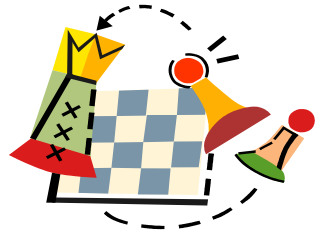

### **ABOUT US...**

The **NCA School of Arts and Enrichment** was created to provide a wide variety of exciting and educational after school enrichment classes for students in Kindergarten through 8th Grade. Students develop skills, learn new skills, and enhance their learning experience. Past classes have included French, science, German, scrapbooking, sign language, Scrabble, basketball skills, chess, art, juggling, drama and sewing. Parents are encouraged to enroll early as each class has limited space and may fill up fast. Classes that do not meet the minimum enrollment requirement may be cancelled. Parents will have the opportunity to enroll their child into another class or receive a refund. **There is no refund for a class once registration is received and the class maintains the original schedule.**

Classes normally meet once per week for 5 or more weeks. Each 5-week block is called a Session. There are usually 5-6 Sessions per school year. Classes begin after school at 3:30 p.m. and end around 4:30 p.m. Teachers of NCA students ensure that students enrolled in after school classes are taken to their appropriate classrooms following regular dismissal. Non-NCA students will need to check in at the reception desk in the front lobby and parents will need to take them to the classroom. **Parents are required to pick up their child(ren) no later than 5 minutes following class dismissal time. After that, children will be checked into after school care and normal fees apply.** Parents must register their child in advance and pay the registration fee. The fee generally covers the cost of the supplies and staff.
