2011-2012 UNIFORM INFORMATION

Dear Parents,

This information on NCA UNIFORMS pertains to the 2011-2012 school year. For your convenience, we have compiled information that we trust will be helpful as you shop for uniforms. We have made some adjustments to our dress code in order to streamline it and make it easier to follow. We have worked with our uniform vendors to determine fair prices and styles that are more up-to-date.

DRESS CODE INFORMATION ATTACHMENTS

The three attached uniform information sheets have been designed to help you navigate our uniform policies, vendors and specifics to our uniform.

- **DRESS CODE SPECIFICS:** This detailed information outlines approved NCA uniform standards for Elementary and Middle School boys and girls.
- **NCA UNIFORM COMPARISON CHART:** This document provides details pertaining to what must be worn on chapel days, PE days and everyday dress code specifics.
- **VENDOR SELECTIONS:** NCA works with three vendors. This document provides information on where to purchase NCA approved uniforms and how to order them.
- **SPIRIT WEAR VS. UNIFORMS:** Pictures of spirit wear and uniforms so that you can differentiate what can/cannot be worn at school.

HERE'S YOUR STARTING POINT

Read through this information very carefully. You can start shopping and/or ordering uniforms for the 2011-2012 school year. (Keep in mind if you purchase items at French Toast or Dennis Uniform, you must order ONLY NCA approved uniforms. Please make sure you use the code NCA has given you. This code will take you to the NCA designated uniform page).

CHANGES/UPDATES TO UNIFORMS (K-8)

PE Uniforms:

- We have added a hunter green NCA PE shirt to the navy and red choices. All official NCA (**with Gators Athletic Dept. logo**) PE uniforms must be ordered from Orca Enterprises.

Spirit Wear and Official Uniforms:

- Spirit Wear will now be selling ONE item that can be worn as everyday uniform (not to be worn on chapel day). Navy blue and red fleece vests with a zipper down the middle may be worn in the classrooms for warmth.

Free Dress Days:

- After a lot of input from you and the uniform committee (made up of teachers and parents,) we are returning to the following Free Dress plan.
- **FREE DRESS DAYS** will be the 2nd Friday of each month. The 4th week will be Walk-a-Thon T-shirt day. The 1st, 3rd and 5th Friday of every month is set aside as uniform day.

Length of skirts/skorts/shorts/jumpers/free dress outfits is as follows: Measuring from the middle of the back of the knee, clothing must not be any shorter than 3 inches. In other words, from the hem of the garment to the center of the back of the knee, must not exceed 3 inches. This is the minimum length allowed. Garments may be longer if desired.

- All uniforms and non-uniform (PE and free dress included) must comply with length requirements.

PE UNIFORMS

Orca Enterprises normally sells PE uniforms in our lobby on Tuesday mornings before school. A schedule will be sent to you to let you know of any changes to this schedule.

PRICES

NCA has found vendors that have quality products for good prices. We do not make any money from vendors (except 5% for all orders placed with French Toast – if you use our school code – funds used to purchase academic resources needed for teachers). Thus, price adjustments and increases are not made by NCA. 2011-2012 prices may have increased. Check the websites of the vendors.

RIGHT TO AMEND

NCA has the right to amend the uniform code at any time with or without notice. NCA has the right to determine whether or not a clothing item(s) meets our code or the mission of our school.

SPIRIT WEAR

Spirit Wear refers to specific clothing and items with NCA logo. With the exception of the navy blue and red fleece zip-up vests, these items are NOT part of NCA's school uniform. These are booster items which show support of the school and may be worn at NCA on free dress days only. The idea is similar to stores that sell sports team T-shirts and paraphernalia, but not the official team uniforms for the professional athlete.

ELEMENTARY GIRLS - Grades K-5

Uniform-Dress Code - 2011-2012

- **NCA UNIFORM COLORS**
- Navy Blue (pants, skirts, cardigan/vest)
 - Forest Green (vest, cardigan)
 - Red (cardigan/vest, tops)
 - White (tops)

Chapel Uniform: Chapel uniform must be worn on chapel day.

- MacBeth plaid jumper or skirt (**only available from Dennis Uniform**).
- **Solid** white collared blouse, soft collared shirt or turtleneck (**no red, navy blue or forest green, no scarf**).
- **Official NCA forest green, red or navy blue cardigan/vest with NCA initials (only available from Dennis Uniform and/or French Toast)** Note: if jumper is worn on chapel day, cardigan/vest is not required. (Zip fleece vest with zipper in front is not chapel dress).

PE Uniform:

- Long or short sleeved navy blue, forest green or red t-shirt **with Gators Athletic Dept. logo (only available from Orca Enterprises)**.
- Solid navy blue sweatpants, warm-up pants or athletic shorts*. All pants/shorts may have thin vertical stripes on left/right side of pants. No letters or numbers on pants. (1 inch Adidas and Nike name/emblem OK). **Note: can be purchased through Orca Enterprises.**
- Optional forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA Gator/logo (only available from Orca Enterprises)**.
- Athletic shoes and socks (in uniform color) must be worn on PE days.
- Regular everyday uniform attire may also be worn on PE days.

Everyday Uniform Choices:

- MacBeth plaid jumper or skirt (**only available from Dennis Uniform**).
- Navy blue jumper, skirt or skort* (no dresses).
- Navy blue pants, capris or hemmed walking shorts*
- Blouse, soft collared shirt or turtleneck in solid red or white. (**only** white on chapel days)
- Official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest **with NCA initials (only available from Dennis Uniform and/or French Toast)**. (**only** white on chapel days)
- Official red or navy blue fleece zipper front vest **with NCA logo. (only available from Orca)** (must not be worn on chapel days)
- Forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA/Gator logo (only available from Orca Enterprises)**. (Not to be worn on chapel days)

Additional Guidelines:

Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only solid colored belts. Only navy blue, black or brown are allowed. No extremes. • One simple bracelet, watch and/or necklace may be worn. No extremes. Earrings must be <u>stud</u> style. • Body piercing (other than ear lobe) and permanent tattooing are not permitted. • Make-up must not be worn to school or applied on campus.
Hair / Hats Sunglasses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Baseball caps/hats or sunglasses must not be worn in the building except when entering & exiting. Only hats may be worn inside on free dress day. • Hair must be neat and only in natural tones. Hair must not cover the eyes. No unnatural color hair extensions.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with socks or tights/nylons/leggings in solid uniform colors only* must be worn at all times. Flip-flops, slippers or open-toed shoes (with or without back straps) may not be worn to school. Closed toed sandals with back straps may be worn. • <i>Note: lace the same color as leggings-only at the bottom of leggings.</i> • Only solid colored tights, socks or leggings in NCA uniform colors (red, navy blue, forest green, white). If worn, need to meet code under length criteria No extremes.
Free Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free dress days: appropriate, modest clothing. No spaghetti straps or tank tops. Shorts, skorts, dresses or skirts must meet length criteria*. (Applies even if student is wearing leggings/tight pants/tights under it.)
Outerwear Sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, coats etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chapel vests/cardigans may be taken off at recess and PE or if student is warm, but must be worn at chapel. • On non-chapel days, the official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest or sweatshirt may be worn in the classroom for warmth. The official NCA fleece vest with zipper front may be worn on any day, but NOT on chapel days. • On chapel days, only official green, red or navy cardigan or vest with NCA initials may be worn in the classroom for warmth. (The zip fleece vest with zipper in front is not chapel dress and must not be worn in class on chapel days) • Outer garments such as non-official NCA (without initials/logo) sweaters, sweatshirts, vests, NCA spirit wear, coats or jackets etc. must not be worn in the classroom.
Shirts / Blouses/Camis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may wear layered, uniform acceptable shirts (1 shirt over the other- white on red or red on white, not navy blue) No tight or immodest tops. – Only uniform white or red, camis or tank tops may be worn under shirts. (NOT ON CHAPEL DAYS)
Skirts / Shorts / etc	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skirts, skorts, jumpers and long shirts (worn as dresses) hems must still meet length criteria* - even if student is wearing leggings/tight pants/nylons/tights under it. No tight or immodest skirts, shorts, skorts, pants etc.
Length Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dress, skirt, skort, and long shirts (worn as dresses) hems must still meet length criteria* even if student is wearing leggings/tight pants/nylons/tights under it. • Length of skirts/skorts/shorts/jumpers/free dress outfits is as follows: Measuring from the middle of the back of the knee, clothing must not be any shorter than 3 inches above the knee. In other words, from the hem of the garment to the center of the back of the knee, must not exceed 3 inches above the knee. This is the minimum length allowed. Garments may be longer if desired. • All uniforms and non-uniform (PE and free dress included) must comply with length/modesty requirements.

Uniform-Dress Code

➤ NCA UNIFORM COLORS

- Navy Blue (pants, cardigan, vest)
- Forest Green (vest, cardigan)
- Red (cardigan, vest, tops)
- White (tops)

Chapel Uniform: Chapel uniform must be worn on chapel day.

- Solid **white** collared dress shirt, soft collared shirt or turtleneck (no red, navy blue or forest green).
- Navy blue pants or hemmed navy blue walking shorts*.
- **Official NCA forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest with NCA initials** (only available from Dennis Uniform and/or French Toast). (Zip fleece vest with zipper in front is **not** chapel dress.)

PE Uniform:

- Long or short sleeved navy blue, forest green or red t-shirt **with Gators Athletic Dept. logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises).
- Solid navy blue sweatpants, warm-up pants or athletic shorts*. All pants/shorts may have thin vertical stripes on left/right side of pants. No letters or numbers on pants. (1 inch Adidas and Nike name/emblem OK). **Note: can be purchased from Orca Enterprises.**
- Optional forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA Gator/ logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises.)
- Athletic shoes and socks (in uniform colors) **must** be worn on PE days.
- Regular everyday uniform attire may also be worn on PE days.

Everyday Uniform Choices:

- Navy blue pants or hemmed walking shorts*.
- Collared dress shirt, soft collared shirt or turtleneck in solid red or white (Only white on chapel days).
- **Official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan/vest with NCA initials** (only available from Dennis Uniform and/or French Toast).
- Official forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA/Gator logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises). (Not to be worn on chapel days)
- Official red or navy fleece front zipper vest **with NCA logo**. Only available from Orca (Not to be worn on chapel days)
- Forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA/Gator logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises). (Not to be worn on chapel days).

Additional Guidelines:

Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only solid colored belts. Only navy, black or brown are allowed. No extremes. • Simple jewelry, watch and/or necklace may be worn. No extremes. • Boys must not wear earrings at school. No body piercing or permanent tattoos are permitted.
Hair / Hats Sunglasses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Baseball caps/hats and sunglasses must not be worn in the building except when entering/exiting. Hats may be worn inside on free dress days. • Hair must be neat and only in natural tones. Hair must be no longer than 1 inch below the collar, and above the eyebrows. Hair must not cover the eyes.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with socks are to be worn at all times. Flip-flops, slippers or open-toed shoes (with or without back straps) must not be worn to school. Closed toed sandals with back straps may be worn. • Only solid uniform colored socks are allowed – Navy blue, red, forest green, white. No extremes.
Free Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free dress days: appropriate, modest clothing. No tight or sagging pants/shorts*. No extremes.
Outerwear Sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, vests, NCA spirit wear, coats etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chapel vests/cardigans may be taken off at recess and PE or if student is warm, but must be worn at chapel. • On non-chapel days, the official green, red or navy cardigan or vest or sweatshirt may be worn in the classroom for warmth. The official NCA fleece vest with zipper front may be worn on any day, but NOT on chapel days. • On chapel days, only official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest with NCA initials may be worn in the classroom for warmth. (The zip fleece vest with zipper in front is not chapel dress and must not be worn in class on chapel days) • Outer garments such as non-official NCA (without initials/logo) sweaters, sweatshirts, vests, NCA spirit wear, coats or jackets etc. must not be worn in the classroom.
Pants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No tight or sagging pants/shorts*.
Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may wear layered, uniform acceptable shirts (1 shirt over the other, white on red or red on white, not navy blue.)
*Length Criteria	<p><u>Length of shorts:</u> Measuring from the middle of the back of the knee, clothing must not be any shorter than 3 inches above the knee. In other words, from the hem of the garment to the center of the back of the knee, must not exceed 3 inches above the knee. This is the minimum length allowed. Garments may be longer if desired.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All uniforms and non-uniform (PE and free dress included) must comply with length/modesty requirements.

MIDDLE SCHOOL GIRLS - Grades: 6-8

Uniform-Dress Code – 2011-2012

Dress Up Days: Middle School students have their own dress up days. These do not coincide with grades K-5.

Free Dress Day: 2nd Friday of each month.

Walk-a-thon Shirt Day: 4th Friday of each month.

Chapel Uniform: Chapel uniform must be worn on chapel day.

- Tan-khaki or navy blue skirt*
- **8th Grade Girls only:** may wear a dressy scarf with white dress blouse.
- Solid white collared dress blouse (no polo shirts) (**no red, navy blue or khaki**) with or without official NCA vest/cardigan.
- Official NCA navy blue, forest green or red cardigan or vest with NCA initials (only available from French Toast and/or Dennis Uniform). (The zip fleece vest with zipper in front is **not** chapel dress.)

PE Uniform:

- Long or short sleeved navy blue, forest green or red t-shirt with **Gators Athletic Dept. logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises).
- Solid navy blue sweatpants, warm-up pants or athletic shorts*– All pants/shorts may have thin vertical stripes on left/right side of pants. No letters or numbers on pants. (1 inch Adidas and Nike name/emblem OK). **Note: can be purchased from Orca Enterprises.**
- Optional: Forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) with **NCA Gator logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises).
- Athletic shoes and socks must be worn on PE days.
- Official NCA athletics/sport team's sweatpants, sweatshirt or T-shirt (soccer, basketball, track and field) may be worn on PE days only.
- Regular everyday uniform attire may also be worn on PE days.

Everyday Uniform Choices:

- Tan-khaki or navy blue pants, skirt, capris, or hemmed walking shorts*.
- Solid white collared dress blouse.
- Soft collared shirt or turtleneck in solid red, white or navy blue. (**Only** white dress blouses on chapel days).
- Official NCA navy blue, red or forest green cardigan/vest with **NCA initials** (only available from French Toast and/or Dennis Uniform).
- Official NCA red or navy blue fleece front zipper vest with **NCA logo** (only available from Orca) (Not to be worn on chapel days).
- Navy blue, red or hunter green sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) with **NCA/GATOR logo** (only available from Orca Enterprises). (Not to be worn on chapel days.)

Additional Guidelines:

Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only solid colored belts. Only navy, black or brown are allowed. No extremes. • Body piercing (other than ear lobe) and permanent tattooing are not permitted. • Simple jewelry may be worn. Earrings should be 1 inch or less in size. No extremes. • Light make-up may be worn to school, but may not be applied at school.
Hair / Hats Sunglasses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Baseball caps/hats or sunglasses must not be worn in the building except when entering & exiting. Only hats may be worn on free dress day. • Hair must be neat and only in natural tones. Hair must not cover the eyes. No unnatural color hair extensions.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with socks or tights/nylons/leggings in solid uniform colors only (red, navy blue, forest green, white) must be worn at all times. <i>Note: lace the same color as leggings-only at the bottom of leggings.</i> • Only solid colored tights, socks or leggings in NCA uniform colors (red, navy blue, forest green, white). If worn, need to meet code under length criteria. No extremes. • Open-toed shoes & sandals are allowed, but with back straps. No flip-flops or slippers etc.
Free Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free dress days: appropriate, modest clothing. No spaghetti straps or tank tops. Shorts, dresses or skirts must meet length criteria. (Applies even if student is wearing leggings/tight pants/tights under it.) No "frays" or "holey" jeans.
Outerwear Sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, vests, NCA spirit wear, coats etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outer garments such as non-official NCA sweaters, sweatshirts, NCA spirit wear, coats or jackets must not be worn in the classroom. • Chapel vests/cardigans may be taken off at recess and PE or if the student is warm, but must be worn at chapel. (See exception under chapel uniform). • On non-chapel days, the official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or chapel vest with NCA initials or NCA Gator sweatshirt may be worn in the classroom for warmth. The official NCA fleece vest with zipper front may be worn on any day, but NOT on chapel days. • On chapel days, only official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or chapel vest with NCA initials may be worn in the classroom for warmth. (The NCA zip fleece vest with zipper in front is not chapel dress and must not be worn in class).
Shirts / Blouses/ Camis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may wear layered, uniform acceptable shirts (1 shirt over the other; 2 different colors are OK as long as they are solid uniform colors*, i.e. white on red or red on white). Only uniform colored camis or tank tops may be worn under shirts. No tight or too short clothing.
Skirts / Shorts/etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dress, skirt, jumpers and long shirts (worn as dresses) hems must still meet length criteria - even if student is wearing leggings/tight pants/nylons/tights under it. No tight or immodest skirts, shorts, pants etc.
*Length Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Length of skirts/shorts/jumpers/free dress outfits is as follows: Measuring from the middle of the back of the knee, clothing must not be any shorter than 3 inches above the knee. In other words, from the hem of the garment to the center of the back of the knee, must not exceed 3 inches above the knee. This is the minimum length allowed. MIDDLE SCHOOL BOYS - Grades 6-8

Uniform-Dress Code - 2011-2012

Dress Up Days: Middle School students have their own dress up days. These do not coincide with grades K-5.

Free Dress Day: 2nd Friday of each month.

Walk-a-thon Shirt Day: 4th Friday of each month.

➤ **NCA UNIFORM COLORS**

- Navy Blue (pants, cardigan/vest, tops)
- Forest Green (cardigan/vest)
- Khaki (pants)
- Red (tops, cardigan/vest)
- White (tops)

Chapel Uniform: Chapel uniform must be worn on chapel day.

- Tan-khaki or navy blue pants (no shorts).
- Solid **white**, dress shirt (no polo shirt) (no red, forest green, navy blue or khaki).
- All shirts must be buttoned and tucked in for chapel service.
- **6-8th Grade:** Neck tie in lieu of cardigan or vest may be worn. Ties must be cinched up to the collar during chapel services.
- Official NCA navy blue, red or forest green cardigan or vest **with NCA initials (only available from French Toast and/or Dennis Uniform)** (Zip fleece vest with zipper in front is **not** chapel dress).

PE Uniform:

- Long or short sleeve navy blue, forest green or red t-shirt **with Gators Athletic Dept. logo (only available from Orca Enterprises)**.
- Solid navy blue sweatpants, warm-up pants or athletic shorts*. All pants/shorts may have thin vertical stripes on left/right side of pants. No letters or numbers on pants. (1 inch Adidas and Nike name/emblem OK). **Note: can be purchased from Orca Enterprises.**
- Optional: forest green, navy blue or red sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA Gator logo (only available from Orca Enterprises)**.
- Athletic shoes and socks must be worn on PE days.
- Official NCA athletics/sport team's sweatpants, sweatshirt or T-shirt (soccer, basketball, track and field) may be worn on PE days only
- Regular everyday uniform attire may also be worn on PE days.

Everyday Uniform Choices:

- Tan-Khaki or navy blue pants or hemmed walking shorts*
- Solid white, collared dress shirt.
- Soft collared shirt or turtleneck in solid red, white or navy blue (must not be worn on chapel day)
- Official NCA forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest **with NCA initials (only available from French Toast and/or Dennis Uniform)**.
- Official red or navy blue fleece zipper front vest **with NCA initials. Only available from Orca Enterprises** (must not be worn on chapel days)
- Navy blue, red or forest green sweatshirt (crewneck or hooded) **with NCA GATOR (only available from Orca Enterprises)**. (Must not be worn on chapel days)

Additional Guidelines:

Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only solid colored belts. Only navy, black or brown are allowed. No extremes. • Simple jewelry, watch and/or necklace may be worn. No extremes. • Boys must not wear earrings at school. No body piercing or permanent tattoos are permitted.
Hair / Hats Sunglasses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Baseball caps/hats and sunglasses must not be worn in the building except when entering/exiting and on free dress days. • Hair must be neat and only in natural tones. Hair must be no longer than 1 inch below the collar, and above the eyebrows. Hair must not cover the eyes. No facial hair is allowed.
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flip-flops, slippers or open-toed shoes (with or without back straps) must not be worn to school. Closed toed sandals with back straps may be worn. • *Only solid uniform colored socks are allowed. No extremes.
Free Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free dress days: appropriate, modest clothing. No tight or sagging pants/shorts*. No extremes. No "frays" or "holey" jeans.
Outerwear Sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets, vests, NCA spirit wear, coats etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chapel vests/cardigans may be taken off at recess and PE or if student is warm, but must be worn at chapel (see exception under chapel uniform). • On non-chapel days, the official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest or NCA Gator sweatshirt may be worn in the classroom for warmth. The official NCA fleece vest with zipper front may be worn on any day, but NOT on chapel days. • On chapel days, only official forest green, red or navy blue cardigan or vest with NCA initials may be worn in the classroom for warmth. (The zip fleece vest with zipper in front is not chapel dress and must not be worn in class on chapel days). • Outer garments such as non-official NCA sweaters, NCA spirit wear, sweatshirts, coats or jackets must not be worn in the classroom.
Pants/shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No tight or sagging pants/shorts*.
Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may wear layered, uniform acceptable shirts (1 shirt over the other; 2 different colors are OK as long as they are solid uniform colors*, i.e. white on red or red on white).
*Length Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Length of shorts: Measuring from the middle of the back of the knee, clothing must not be any shorter than 3 inches above the knee. In other words, from the hem of the garment to the center of the back of the knee, must not exceed 3 inches. This is the minimum length (above the knee) allowed. Garments may be longer if desired. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All uniforms and non-uniform (PE and free dress included) must comply with length/modesty requirements.
