

# Spanish Class

**Third Graders** are using the text book “Una Semana con Gabi” and we are now doing lesson #3. The vocabulary that the students will learn during this next week is: el miércoles (On Wednesday), la casa (the house), limpia (he/she cleans), está sucio/sucia (he/she/it is dirty), busca (he/she looks for), enchufa (he/she plugs in), la cola (the tail), pasa la aspiradora (he/she vacuums), ¡Qué lío! (What a mess!); also our thematic unit is La Casa (rooms in the house) and Animal Names. Latino culture: dancing Bachata. They will sing: “Bueno es Alabar al Señor” (It’s Good to Worship you Lord). We will be counting in Spanish from 0-30.

**Fourth Grade:** We are using the text book “Gabi la Aventurosa” and we will do Lesson #8. The vocabulary for this month is: el domingo (on Sunday), el control remoto (the remote control), sale (he/she leaves), la vecindad (the neighborhood), el garage/los garages (the garage/s) se abren (they open –themselves-), se cierran (they close–themselves-), se prenden (they turn–themselves–on) se apagan (they turn-s–themselves-off), and ¡Qué curioso! (How strange!). Our thematic unit will be: Modes of Transportation. They will sing: “Ven, es Tiempo de Adorarlo” (Come, Now is the Time to Worship). We will be counting in Spanish from 1-1,000.

**Fifth Grade:** Our text book is “Gabi la Aventurosa” and we will do Episodio #13. The new vocabulary is: Está curioso/a (he/she is curious), explora (he/she explores), el ramo (the branch), el árbol (the tree), el mono (the monkey), se enoja (he/she gets mad), and ¡Dale! (Step on it!). They will sing, “Vine a Adorate” (Here I am to Worship). The thematic unit will be: Islands Animals. We will continue counting in Spanish from 1-10,000.

**Sixth Grade :** Our text book is “Gabi la Viajera” and we will do Episodio #17. The new vocabulary is: va de vacaciones (he/she goes on vacation), la calle (the street), el banco (the bank), el ladrón (the thief), roba (he/she steals), la lucha (the fight), resulta una lucha (a fight break out), las monedas (the coins), and ¡Disculpe! (Excuse me! Pardon me!). The thematic unit will be: Money and Currency and Family Members. We will be counting in Spanish from 1-10,000 and they will sing: “Vine a Adorate” (Here I am to Worship).

**Spanish Beginner A and B:** We are reading the novel “Pobre Ana”. This month we will cover chapters 4-6, count in Spanish from 0 to 1,000,000 and learn how to tell the time. Grammar: definite articles (el, la, los y las) and indefinite articles (un, una, unos, unas), me gusta y no me gusta and interrogative pronouns. We will sing the first 4 songs of the Pobre Ana CD and sing: “Gracias” (Thank you).

**Advanced Spanish:** We are reading the novel “Piratas del Caribe”. This month we will cover Chapters 6-8 and count in Spanish from 0 to 1,000,000. Grammar: Verb -to be– (Ser o Estar), demonstrative adjectives, me gusta y no me gusta, the articles and possessive adjectives. They will sing: “Eres mi Amigo Fiel” (Friend of God).
