WHAT'S UP IN SPANISH THIS MONTH?

Kindergartners demonstrate comprehension of this year’s vocabulary by saying the words the teacher signs, + colors, and numbers 1-15. New words and phrases are: FELÍZ (happy), FURIOSO (furious), NERVIOSO (nervous), CANSADO (tired), TRISTE (sad), ENFERMO (sick), GRÁCIAS (thank you), and DE NADA (you’re welcome).

First Graders can sing Rey de Reyes, Señor de Señores (King of Kings and Lord of Lords) really fast! Their Spanish-speaking muscles are developing like crazy!! The students are learning a new song: “El Amor de Dios es Maravilloso” (The Love of God is Marvellous) and are creating, acting in, and reading out loud their own variations of a story using all vocabulary learned this year.

Second Grade students have been practicing family words: PADRE (father), MADRE (mother), HIJO (son), HIJA (daughter) and learning new verbs: GATEA (he/she/it crawls), PREPARA (he/she/it prepares) and nouns: EL PUPITRE (the student desk), LA SILLA (the chair), EL PISO (the floor), LA PARED (the wall), and EL BAÑO (the bathroom). Their newest phrase is: ¡BASTA! (Enough!)
